Title	<i>Recent efforts in supporting developmental math at SVSU</i>
Abstract	<p>SVSU was awarded a Title III grant worth \$3 million over 5 years. While the grant has many components, a key emphasis is improving success in developmental math (defined as MATH 081, 082, and 103). I will describe the efforts currently under way which can be divided into two main goals: (1) Design new curricula for students placed in developmental courses; (2) Create supplemental resources for teaching and learning developmental mathematics. The goal here is to produce new materials that will support SVSU faculty and students in a wide variety of ways. Rather than being tied to particular courses, these resources should be modular and freely accessible to SVSU students and faculty, so that they can be plugged in as needed to any math-related courses and support the study needs of our students. In particular I will highlight “SVSU Micro Math”, a math video library which is now available in basic form.</p>
