Title	A new insect species discovered in Michigan
Abstract	A new species of <i>Docosia</i> Winnertz fungus gnat was discovered in western Michigan. Males and females were collected in mid-spring in a Malaise trap in a paper birch-red maple-black cherry woods adjacent to black ash swamp and cattail marsh. <i>Docosia walpurga</i> Taber resembles <i>Docosia dichroa Loew</i> but male terminalia and female coloration indicate a specific difference instead. A remarkable and yet-unidentified empidid fly that seems to mimic the fungus gnat was found with the new species.
