## Transfer Credit, Including Credit by Examination

Students must submit official records directly from the source institution for all transfer courses, including credit by examination reports. Upon receipt of these records the Registrar's Office will evaluate the transcripts according to the general policies of the University and subject to the review of the appropriate academic department. A Transfer Evaluation Report (TER) provides students with an official record of how their credits transferred to Saginaw Valley.

- The University will review unofficial or incomplete transcripts to assist students at the time of
  their initial enrollment, but all students must submit official records from the source institution in
  order to receive credit. Students who do not provide official final records will not be fully
  admitted to SVSU and are prohibited from further enrollment until these records are
  received.
- The minimum acceptable grade for transfer credits is a "C-". Courses with a grade below "C-" are not transferable.
- Appeals of transfer credit evaluations must be made in writing to the Associate Registrar and should include appropriate supporting materials (i.e. course descriptions, syllabi, etc).
- All Advanced Placement (AP) credits require a minimum score of "3" or "4" in order to receive
  credit at Saginaw Valley, depending on the test. Scores for other forms of credit by exam may
  vary depending on the testing source.
- Remedial courses do not transfer to Saginaw Valley, but equivalencies of these courses are recognized for completing Basic Skill requirements and in meeting course prerequisites.

## **Transfer Credit Limitations**

The following limitations apply to all sources of transfer credit:

- 1. The maximum number of credits accepted from all sources is 93 credits.
- 2. The maximum number of credits accepted from all two-year institutions is 62 credits.
- 3. For students whose total transfer credits exceed the above mentioned limitations, the University will transfer the maximum acceptable number of credits that best apply toward a specific major or academic program.
- 4. Transfer credits are not included when computing the SVSU GPA. Grades received from transfer credits are not included in the SVSU GPA, but these grades may be referenced by individual academic departments when granting admission to their respective programs.

## **ADVISING TIP: PROCRASTINATION = BLOCKED**

Students with incomplete or unofficial records are prohibited or "blocked" from registration if their official records have not been received by the university. You will not be able to register beyond your first semester so <u>make sure your records have been sent and received by Saginaw Valley</u>. Don't delay this process!!
