Registrations:

A passport is required at time of registration and the passport must be valid through six months following the end date of the tour (September 25, 2025).

Tour Activity Level:

This tour requires above average physical activity. You should be in good health, able to climb stairs, hills and walk reasonable distances, walking up to three hours per day at one time, possibly over uneven ground and cobblestone streets. Travelers should be healthy enough to participate in all included walks without assistance. Adding optional excursions may increase the total amount of walking on your tour. You should feel comfortable managing your own baggage at all times. If you have any mobility concerns or physical restrictions, please contact our OLLI office for additional information.

We will stay in accommodations handpicked to ensure quality and comfort. Specific hotel details will be given at the pre-trip dinner.

Day 1: Thursday, March 13 (SVSU → Lisbon)

Depart SVSU via motorcoach for our overnight flight from Detroit to Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2: Friday, March 14 (Lisbon)

Arrival in Lisbon (D)

Welcome to Portugal! Settle in after your overnight flight to Lisbon, where we will be staying for the next two nights, enjoy for your welcome dinner, and meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers. The dinner will feature dishes that are typical of the region.

Day 3: Saturday, March 15 (Lisbon)

Sightseeing Tour of Lisbon (B)

Following breakfast we'll set off on a guided tour to discover the Portuguese capital, Lisbon, with a local guide. During this tour, we will see the city from Eduardo VII Park and pass through the Praça Marquês de Pombal as we travel along Avenida da Liberdade. We'll stop at the waterfront to discover the city's maritime heritage at the Monument to the Discoveries and Tower of Belém. We will also stop to view the outside of the church at Jerónimos Monastery, which was built to honor voyagers. We'll end our guided tour by walking to the Time Out Market through the heart of the city to Praça do Comércio. Enjoy a your evening in Lisbon on your own, **OR** add the Lisbon Cooking Class & Dinner. During this four hour adventure, individuals will learn to cook a three-course meal featuring traditional Portuguese cuisine.

Day 4: Sunday, March 16 (Seville)

Seville via Évora (B/D)

This morning we will join a local guide on a tour of UNESCO-recognized Évora, one of Europe's oldest continuously inhabited cities. During this tour, we will be able to view the region's whitewashed homes and intricate tilework. We will pass the remains of the Roman temple and enter the Chapel of Bones. Following the end of the tour, we will continue on to Seville, Spain where we will stay two nights. Once we arrive, we will sit down for an included dinner.

Day 5: Monday, March 17 (Seville)

Sightseeing Tour of Seville & Food Walking Tour (B/D/Wine Tasting)

After breakfast we will begin our day on a guided tour of Seville to uncover the beauty of the historic Andalusian capital. We will view the tiled pavilion of the Plaza de España, pass the whitewashed homes of Barrio de Santa Cruz, and enter the Gothic Seville Cathedral (the third largest church in the world). This evening we will join a local guide for a food-themed walking tour through the charming Triana neighborhood. During this tour, we will stroll along the river, learn about the history of tapas and Andalusian gastronomy before we try our first tapas bar. As we continue on, we will hear about the history of Barrio, the birthplace of Falemnco, and view beautiful ceramic tiles as you gain a new insight on the city while you feast on delicious plates of tapas.

Day 6: Tuesday, March 18 (Granada)

Granada via Olive Oil Farm (B/D)

This morning after breakfast we will leave Seville and begin our journey to Granada. Along our journey, we will stop to discover some of the flavors of Andalusia. We will be stopping at an olive oil farm and join a local guide for a tour of the olive groves, mill, and cellar. We will be sampling some orange-infused olive oil drizzled on top of chocolate gelato. You will have some free time to shop. Then we will continue back on our journey to Granada, where we will sit down for an included dinner.

Day 7: Wednesday, March 19 (Granada)

Sightseeing Tour of the Alhambra & Flamenco Show (B)

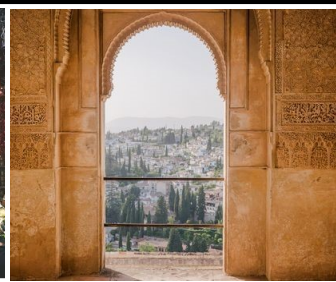
Today we will go on a guided tour of the UNESCO-recognized Alhambra, the Moorish sultans' last stronghold in Spain. During our tour we will, walk along the Cypress Promenade to view the upper and lower gardens of Generalife Palace. We will enjoy the panoramic views overlooking Granada and the surrounding countryside. We will view the unique curved, Roman-style courtyard inside the Palace of Charles V, admire the blend of Western art and Islamic design as you stroll through ornamented courtyards, enter the Nasrid Palaces and see the Mexuar, where the Council of Ministers met, and we will see where the royal family lived during visits to Comares Palace and the Palace of the Lions. *Please note: The order of these activities are subject to change.* Tonight, we will go to a traditional cave dug into the hillsides, where we will sip an included drink as we watch one-of-a-kind art form of Flamenco, in the region where it was created. Flamenco is a unique and colorful Andalusian art form that combines guitar playing, singing, clapping, and dancing. UNESCO declared Flamenco to be one of the Masterpieces of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity.

Day 8: Thursday, March 20 (Madrid)

Madrid via Córdoba (B)



We will enjoy breakfast before beginning our journey to Madrid, where we will stay for the next three nights. But first we will transfer through the Andalusian countryside to Córdoba, which is Europe's largest medieval city. We will be taken on a guided tour upon arrival. We will view the Calleja de las Flores, enter the Mezquita (a UNESCO World Heritage site built in the eighth century as a mosque and then converted into a cathedral during the Reconquista), and we will walk through the Old Town and Jewish Quarter. Once we finish our tour, we will board a high-speed train and travel to Madrid. *Please note: Porterage is not included for the train transfers. Travelers must be comfortable lifting and carrying all luggage over steps, onto platforms, and into the luggage storage.*



Day 9: Friday, March 21 (Madrid)

Sightseeing Tour of Madrid (B/Wine Tasting)

Today, following breakfast, we will get an insider’s view of Spain’s bustling capital city with a local guide. We will pass by the Temple of Debod, a reassembled temple from ancient Egypt. Then we will visit the Royal Palace, which is the largest royal residence in Spain. Next we will walk from Old Madrid to Plaza Mayor, one of the city’s main squares. At the square we will sample wine and tapas at San Miguel Market, whose 30 stalls offer foods from all over Spain. Then we will explore the Prado, a world-class art museum that began as the private collection of the Spanish monarchy and is home to works by Goya, Velázquez, and other major artists. Enjoy this evening on your own to explore, **OR** add the Traditional Spanish Evening excursion. This excursion includes an evening stroll through Madrid and enjoy the live music at one of the oldest restaurants in the city. Dinner is included in this excursion.

Day 10: Saturday, March 22 (Madrid)

Free Day in Madrid (B)

Today is yours for the choosing, you may explore Madrid **OR** add the Toledo excursion. The Toledo excursion will be all day as you explore Toledo, the cliff-top city often referred to as La Ciudad Imperial (“The Imperial City”).

Day 11: Sunday, March 23 (Barcelona)

Train to Barcelona (B)

Today we will board a high-speed train and travel to Barcelona. Then, enjoy a free evening in the city **OR** add the Park Güell & La Pedrera excursion. During this excursion, you will learn about Antoni Gaudí, the famed Spanish architect known for his bold, distinct designs. You will go through Park Güell and see marvelous work and at the top of the park, you will be able to see the brilliant views of Barcelona.

Day 12: Monday, March 24 (Barcelona)

Sightseeing Tour of Barcelona (B/Farewell Dinner)

This morning we will begin on a guided tour with a local of the Catalanian capital. On this tour, we will step inside La Sagrada Família, Gaudí’s famous masterwork-in-progress. We will drive along Passeig de Gràcia, past Gaudí’s “House of Bones”. We will stop at Montjuïc, which is the park where the 1992 Olympic Games took place, and stroll through Mirador de l’Alcalde Park. Then pass through Plaça d’Espanya. This evening we will celebrate the trip at the farewell dinner.

Day 13: Tuesday, March 25 (Barcelona → SVSU)

Departure (B)

Today we will head back home to Michigan. Breakfast will be included today unless we have an early morning flight.

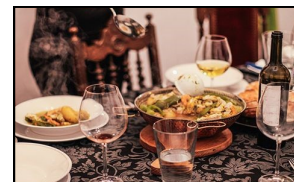

Day 3: Lisbon Cooking Class & Dinner \$129 pp

(4 hours, departs in evening, dinner included)

Under the guidance of a professional chef, you’ll cook a three-course meal featuring traditional Portuguese cuisine. Learn about the country’s most famous foods and the flavors that make them unique to this corner of the world. Then, enjoy eating your meal for dinner alongside a glass of regional wine. *This excursion requires advance reservation.*



Day 9: Traditional Spanish Evening \$115 pp

(3 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

Start the evening with a stroll through Plaza Mayor. Your Tour Director will tell you about the history of the square, where you’ll see locals and travelers alike. On your way to dinner, walk through the illuminated streets of Madrid, taking in the local neighborhood ambiance in the evening light. Then, enjoy conversation, camaraderie, and live music at one of the oldest restaurants in the city. Between traditional Castilian courses, you’ll be entertained by tuno music, an artistic tradition with its roots in Spain’s universities.



Day 10: Toledo \$99 pp

(8 hours, departure time varies)

Under Discover Toledo, the cliff-top city often referred to as La Ciudad Imperial (“The Imperial City”). Upon arrival, you’ll have some free time to explore. Later in the afternoon, your guided tour begins at Toledo Cathedral, a massive, Gothic structure that houses 750 medieval stained glass windows and a treasure trove of golden artifacts. Gaze upon the cathedral’s sacristy, containing masterpieces by the likes of van Dyck, El Greco, Rubens, and Titian. After exploring the labyrinth of medieval alleyways at the heart of the city, you’ll visit the Church of Santo Tomé and one of Europe’s oldest synagogues, Santa María la Blanca. *Please note: This tour involves some walking over uneven terrain. Also, depending on the day of the week, the sites visited are subject to change.*

Day 11: Park Güell & La Pedrera \$105 pp

(4 hours, departure time varies)

On today’s excursion, discover the magnificent works of Antoni Gaudí, the famed Spanish architect known for his bold, distinct designs. Casa Milà is the first stop. Take a guided tour of this building, popularly known as “La Pedrera,” which was built by Gaudí between 1905 and 1910. Everything about the building is visually unique, from the wave-like stone structure and grandly designed roof to the apartment that reflects the style of the 20th-century bourgeois. Next, you’ll head to Park Güell, also designed by Gaudí. Your guide will lead you through the park, which contains stunning buildings, intricate stonework, and colorful mosaics. At the top of the park, marvel at the brilliant views of Barcelona.

I (or parent or legal guardian if enrollee is under 18 or a minor under any other applicable law) am an enrollee on an EF Go Ahead Tour and understand and agree to the following:

1. I acknowledge and understand that my tour is operated by EF Education First International Ltd., Switzerland, and that Go Ahead Vacations, Inc. acts only as a marketing service provider for that company. Go Ahead Vacations, Inc. does not provide any goods or services for your trip. If I am participating in a domestic tour in the U.S., I understand that a portion of my tour may be operated by EF Explore America, Inc., a U.S. affiliate.

2. EF Education First International Ltd., Go Ahead Vacations, Inc., and (if applicable) EF Explore America, Inc., and their affiliated companies, partners, and any companies acting on their behalf, along with their officers, directors, employees, agents, and authorized representatives (collectively referred herein as "GAT") do not own or operate any entity which is to or does provide goods or services for my tour, including for example hotels; arrangements for, ownership of, or control over houses, apartments, or other lodging facilities; tour directors; airline, vessel, bus, or other transportation companies; local ground operators; visa processing services; providers or organizers of optional excursions; or food service or entertainment providers. I acknowledge that all such persons and entities, specifically the Tour Director assigned to my tour, are independent contractors and not employees or agents of GAT. As a result, GAT is not liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person or entity, or of any other third party.

3. Without limitation, GAT is not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage to person or property, death, disease, sickness, delay or inconvenience in connection with the provision of any goods or services occasioned by or resulting from any event or cause beyond the direct control of GAT or as a result of any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any third party. 4. I agree to release GAT, my Group Coordinator (if applicable), and my Tour Director (the "Released Parties") from, and agree not to sue the Released Parties for, any and all claims, of any nature related in any manner to my participation in a GAT-sponsored tour, including, but not limited to, claims for negligence, breach of contract, breach of express or implied warranties, negligent or wrongful death or any statutorily based claim. I hereby unconditionally and unequivocally waive any and all claims and demands for all damages, losses, costs and expenses of any nature whatsoever (including attorney's fees) on account of or arising out of any and all personal injury, death, bodily injury, mental anguish, emotional distress, property or other damage that I may suffer from any cause whatsoever related in any way to my participation in any GAT-sponsored tour. I further agree to release and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all decisions to cancel, modify or delay the tour as a result of events that are beyond the reasonable control of GAT including such "acts of God" or force majeure events as actual or threats of: epidemics or pandemics, or other public health issues or emergencies (such as but not limited to the current COVID-19 pandemic); severe weather events or natural disasters such as but not limited to hurricanes, earthquakes, tsunamis, tornadoes, fires, floods, volcanic activity, or landslides; war (whether declared or undeclared); terrorist activities; instability in a destination location; incidents of violence, riot, sabotage, civil commotion, or nationalization; strikes or labor disputes or lockouts; government orders, sanctions, actual or potential quarantines, or other restrictions affecting travel in, to, or around a location; disruption to transportation; chemical or radioactive contamination; or any other reason that makes it actually or potentially impossible or illegal for GAT to conduct the tour as originally contracted.

5. I understand that travel can involve inconvenience and risk, including, but not limited to, sickness, diseases, forces of nature, geographic and climatic conditions, different hygienic standards, infrastructure problems (including road maintenance, transportation delays and accommodation condition), civil unrest, vandalism, crime, political instability and terrorism. Medical services or facilities may not be readily available or available at all during all or a portion of the tour and, if available, may not be equal to standards in my home location or home country. I further understand that travel in other nations is not similar to travel in the United States and that different parts of the world present unique health, disease, and safety concerns, and I agree to review any specific risks related to my destination by visiting the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Traveler's Health website at www.cdc.gov/travel and the State Department's International Travel website at www.state.gov/travel. I assume all risk of bodily injury, death, emotional trauma, property damage, inconvenience and/or loss resulting from negligence or any other acts of any and all persons or entities, however caused, including, but not limited to, those risks mentioned above. It is my intention fully to assume all of the risks of travel and participation in the program and to GAT from any and all liabilities to the maximum extent permitted by law.

6. I agree that the releases of liability included herein apply to and bind myself and any minor child who am enrolling as a parent/legal guardian, along with all personal representatives, executors, heirs, and family.

7. GAT shall have no responsibility for me whatsoever when I am absent from GAT supervised activities or for non-supervised activities.

8. My tour begins with the takeoff from the GAT departure airport and ends upon completion of the flight back to the origination (or other arrival) airport. I also understand that should local authorities be involved, I will be subject to the laws of the country I am visiting.

GAT retains the right and has my authorization, in its sole discretion, to contact my emergency contact(s) with regard to health issues or any matter whatsoever that relates to my tour. In the event of a medical emergency, GAT will attempt to cause appropriate treatment to be administered, and I authorize GAT to do so. GAT, however, makes no warranty that it will be able to cause effective (or any) emergency treatment to be administered and GAT will not be responsible for monitoring any health care that I may necessitate.

14. I understand and agree that GAT has the right to make changes in tour itineraries and departure dates, and to modify transportation arrangements, including the use of substitute airlines. In the event of such changes, refunds will be given only in accordance with the provisions of the Booking Conditions supplied herewith.

15. I understand that it is my responsibility to secure the necessary travel documents (e.g., passport, visa [s], vaccination records, or other required medical records for all locations on my tour (including locations visited during transit). Failure to do so does not constitute grounds for a refund except according to the refund and cancellation guidelines as outlined in the Booking Conditions.

16. GAT is not responsible for loss of passports, airline tickets, or other documents, or for loss of or damage to luggage or any other passenger belongings. In the case of a lost paper airline ticket or missing a flight booked by GAT, I acknowledge that I am solely responsible for meeting the airline's requirements (both logistical and financial) for ticket replacement.

17. I understand that I will be required to pay for any phone calls or incidental personal expenses that I incur at hotels, as well as for any damage I cause to hotel rooms, buses or other property.

18. I represent that I understand the pacing, content, accommodations, and other aspects of the tour upon which I have enrolled, and that I have discussed with GAT any limitations that may make it difficult or impossible for me to participate in this tour as designed.

19. I understand and agree that this Release & Agreement and GAT's Booking Conditions constitute the entire agreement between GAT and me with reference to the subject matter herein, and I do not rely upon any promises, inducements or agreements not herein, including but not limited to any oral statements made to me by any agents or employees of GAT. This agreement may be amended or modified only in writing, signed by both parties. The waiver by GAT of any provision of this agreement shall in no way affect the remaining provisions of this agreement, and this agreement shall be interpreted as if such clause or provision were not contained herein. If any provision of this agreement is deemed illegal, unenforceable or invalid in any jurisdiction, it shall not affect the enforceability and validity of any other provision of his agreement.

20. I understand and agree that this agreement shall be governed in all respects, and performance hereunder shall be judged, by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. In the event of any claim, dispute or proceeding arising out of my relationship with GAT, or any claim which in contract, tort, or otherwise at law or in equity arises between me and the Released Parties, whether or not related to this agreement, all parties submit and consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the courts of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and of the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts.

21. I understand and consent that GAT may use any photographic, film, digital or video likeness taken of me, any of my comments while on a Go Ahead tour, any of my photographic, film, digital or video content shared by me with GAT through any form for future publicity or marketing without compensation to me and to also use my contact information for future GAT promotions. I have read and agreed to GAT's Privacy Policy outlined at www.goaheadtours.com/privacy, and I consent to GAT's processing of my personal data.

22. I understand that my enrollment on tour with GAT is not complete until I have signed and agreed to the Terms & Conditions and this Release & Agreement. By agreeing to this Release & Agreement and Booking Conditions on behalf of other travelers for whom I am completing the enrollment process, I represent that I am authorized to act on behalf of such individual(s) and I acknowledge and affirm that GAT's reliance on my authority is reasonable. I agree to indemnify and defend GAT for any claims arising out of any violation of this representation.
