

You'll pass by the Champs Elysees, the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame, and other landmarks. Perhaps you'll join us for this afternoon's optional Versailles tour before enjoying time at leisure. **Please note:** Due to limited space, the Versailles optional tour must be reserved at least ten days prior to departure and cannot be booked on-site. Versailles is the most-visited attraction in France. To ensure that all guests are able to view the exhibits, the time you spend in each room is limited by palace staff. Expect lines at the entrance in peak season, even for groups with reservations. B—Novotel Paris Eiffel Tower or similar

Day 12 Paris/Optional Giverny tour. Today, explore on your own. Or join us on an optional half-day visit to idyllic Giverny, where Monet painted his Impressionist works. This evening, savor a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant with your fellow travelers. B,D—Novotel Paris Eiffel Tower or similar



On Day 10, go ashore in picturesque Honfleur for an included walking tour of this historic port.
