STUDENT CONDUCT HEARING BOARD

- ❖ The Board operates under the Code of Student Conduct procedures.
- ❖ The Board is comprised of faculty, staff and students.
- * Responsibility for evaluating information submitted at hearings and setting appropriate sanctions.

MEMBERSHIP

- ❖ Board members must be in good standing with the University.
- ❖ Board members typically dedicate no more than 1-2 hours per week, and each board member can determine the frequency of his/her participation.

JURISDICTION

❖ The Board hears cases for students and student organizations in response to charges of the Code of Student Conduct.

TYPES OF VIOLATIONS

- ❖ Any violation that is handled by Residential Life and/or Student Conduct Programs staff can be referred to the University Student Conduct Hearing Board.
- * Regulations are found in the Code Student Conduct, the Resident Student Handbook, and the University Housing Agreement.
