Performance Indicators
(Holistic Scorepoint Description)
Grade 10

The following is a guideline to how the writing process is scored at the tenth grade level:

4 Mature	The writing is engaging, original, focused, and organized. Ideas and content are developed and supported by details and examples where appropriate. The writer is capable of expressing the chosen point of view and effectively conveys it to the chosen audience. Skillful and accurate writing conventions contribute to writing effect.
3 Capable	The writing is clear and focused. Ideas and content are developed and supported by details and examples where appropriate. The writer considers audience and point of view. Minimal mistakes are accepted in writing conventions.
2 Developing	The writing is somewhat focused and organized. Ideas and content developed with limited details and examples. Structure development beginning to take form. Voice and tone are inconsistent. Limited control of writing conventions may interfere with meaning.
1 Emerging	Writing response demonstrates the attempt to reflect one's own writing. Little focus or development; little support for ideas, faulty sentence structure, and limited vocabulary interfere with understanding. Very limited control of writing conventions, which makes writing difficult to read.
