Recycling containers are provided in each housing unit. Recyclable materials are to be dropped off in the large green recycle dumpsters conveniently located near your facility.

Please be courteous of others' recycling efforts, do not mix trash or heavy food waste with recycled materials. Tainted materials increase the cost of sorting, and could taint materials that others have carefully prepared for recycling (potentially resulting in landfill disposal of the materials).
