### Getting to Campus and Main Entrances

Saginaw Valley State University is located at 7400 Bay Road in University Center, Michigan. Bay Road runs north–south along the western edge of campus and serves as the primary access corridor. The main campus entrances connect Bay Road to College Drive, which leads into the central academic area. Visitor parking is available near the central campus core.

### Campus Orientation Overview

The central campus area contains most academic buildings, student services, and dining locations. Residence halls are primarily located to the north and south of the academic core. Athletic and recreational facilities are located around the perimeter of the central campus area.

## **Parking Information**

### **Visitor Parking**

Visitor parking is available in designated parking lots near the central campus area. Visitors are encouraged to park near the Student Center, Wickes Hall, or other central academic buildings depending on their destination. Parking signs and pay stations provide additional guidance where applicable.

### **Student Parking**

Student parking is available in lots designated for commuter, resident, and village parking. Permit requirements vary by residence type and lot location. Students should park only in areas authorized by their parking permit.

### **Faculty and Staff Parking**

Faculty and staff parking is available in designated lots throughout campus. Permit-required areas are clearly marked and enforced during posted hours.

### **Accessible Parking**

Accessible parking spaces are available near all major academic buildings, residence halls, and student service locations. Accessible spaces are marked with signage and pavement markings and require a valid state-issued accessibility permit.

## **Accessibility and Safety Information**

Power-assist doors are available at select building entrances. Emergency blue light telephones are located throughout campus to provide direct access to campus police.
